Please note: The fashion show is recommended for children 5 years old and up.

Tickets to the American Girl Fashion Show at Plimoth Plantation are priced \$40 per person for Plimoth Plantation museum members, and \$55 per person for the general public. **Tickets include admission** to the award-winning museum, which can be used, either on the day of the fashion show, or **anytime during the month of April**. The museum is offering this special expanded admission, so that attendees can spend some time learning about the Native Wampanoag and Colonial English families of 17th century Plimoth. All proceeds from the American Girl Fashion Show at Plimoth Plantation will benefit Plimoth Plantation's Education Department, which serves school groups and teachers from all across the country.
