

May Baskets

MATERIALS

Basket template (see next page)

Scissors

Glue Stick

Construction paper or cardstock (optional)

Crayons, markers, and/or colored pencils

Decorative craft items like ribbon, lace, stickers, sequins, etc.

MAKING YOUR BASKET

Print the game template on the next page. Cut along the dotted lines to create two pieces — a quarter circle shape and a long thin rectangle. This will be your basket and its handle.

For a sturdier basket, use the template as a guide to cut the same shapes from heavier paper like cardstock or construction paper.

Decorate one side of the basket piece however you like using materials you have around the house. We've provided a label you can cut out and attach to your basket to get you started! While you are decorating, be sure to leave a margin of about a half inch of one of the straight edges free of decoration. This area is marked on the template.

When you are finished decorating, line the blank straight edge thoroughly with glue. Curling the paper, glue the straight edges together with some overlap to form a cone. Fill the basket with candy, flowers, or small gifts to give to someone you love!
